5. <u>Natural Standard</u> (*link removed*) Evidence-based information & images about complementary and alternative medicine & drugs

6. <u>Thomson Clinical Xpert</u> (from MICROMEDEX) Drug info and drug interaction database, clinical topic summaries

<u>Drug Information Portal</u> *(link removed)* was launched in late February; it "gives the public, healthcare professionals, and researchers a gateway to current, accurate and understandable drug information from the National Library of Medicine and other key government agencies." *(from the official <u>press release</u> (link removed))* There are over 12,000 records with links to MedlinePlus, PubMed, and other NLM databases.

<u>MedlinePlus.gov</u> (*link removed*),a consumer-oriented, free website, debuted a multilingual feature, providing access to high quality health information in languages other than English and Spanish in May. "The new collection contains over 2,500 links to information in more than 40 languages and covers nearly 250 Health Topics. Continuous growth is expected."

NLM and the <u>Office of Research on Women's Health</u> (*link removed*) announced a new web resource in March. <u>Women's Health Resources</u> (*link removed*) aims to be a one-stop location for "consumers, health care providers, and researchers [who] will be able to more quickly access the latest information available on scientific developments for important issues related to women."

<u>Auxiliary Enterprises</u> (*link removed*) has rolled out new Pay-for-Print software and hardware. The Isché Library already has new print stations on both the 3rd floor & the 4th floor. The price for printing is now 8¢ per single page and 12¢ for double sided. Printing in the Library will continue to require a <u>PayPaw</u> (*link removed*) card.
