All donated materials must be in good condition. Items accepted become property of the LSUHSC-New Orleans Libraries, and as such, we reserve the right to determine retention and location of the donated items. Whereas the wishes of the donor will be considered and respected as much as possible, we will make decisions with regards to the storage, display, access, and disposal of items following best practices established for libraries and archives.

The Libraries do not have the means to pick up donations from private residences or offices. If the donations are on campus, it may be possible for a librarian to preview and pick up some materials at your location. A donation form is available online or at the Libraries, and a form must be submitted in order to receive a formal acknowledgment and inventory of your donation. IRS regulations prohibit the Libraries from appraising donated material. Determining the value of donated materials is the responsibility of the donor.
