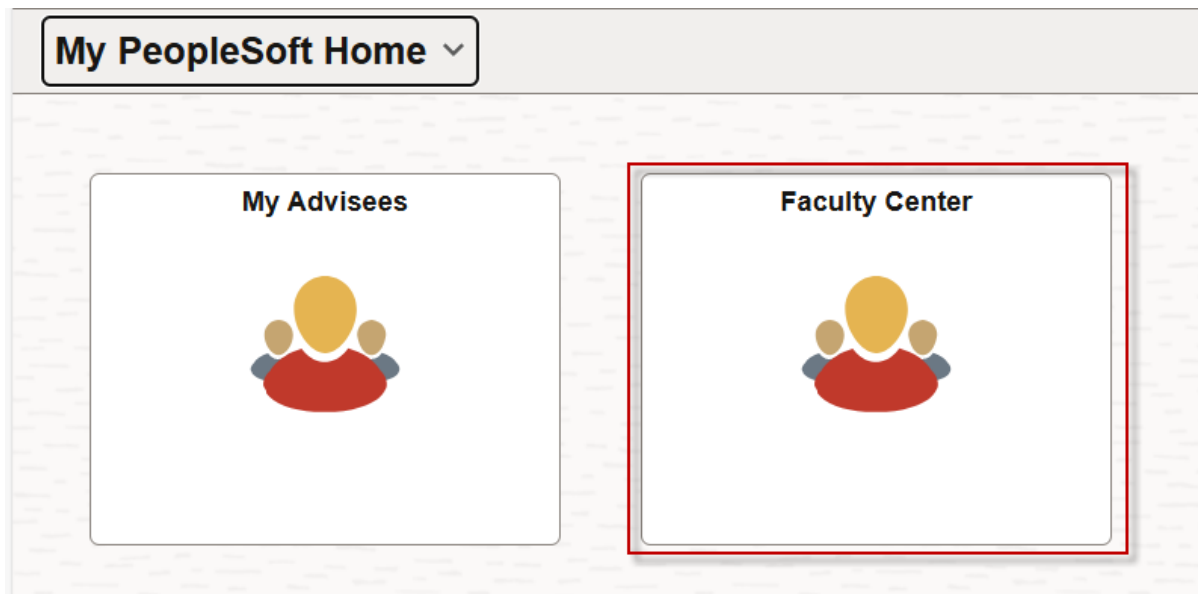
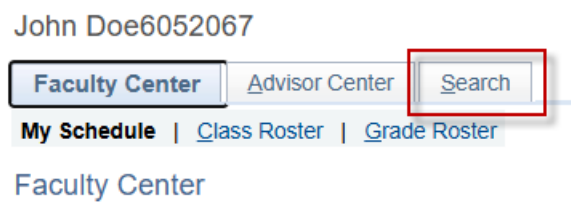

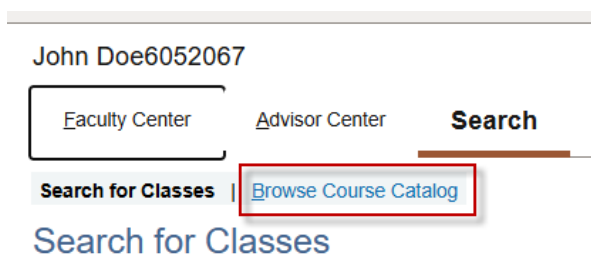

Description

Students will see new continuity patients in the clinic, and perform chart reviews on additional patients seen during Block 1 and Block 2 as demonstrated by the log.
Students will be evaluated by faculty based on expected achievement for late-clinical acting including: professional attitude, communication, independent development of assessment and plans based on their problem focused history and physical exam of patients, their use of point care resources (including USPSTF guidelines) for improved patient care, their application of preventative guidelines including immunizations, and attention to FU needs.
Students will complete the NMBE Subject examination.
